WHAT IS THIS RUNWAY MODULE?

This is a simple jCarousel module created for Runway.
You can read all about what it can and cannot do in the category **Functionality**.

CAN I CHANGE THE LOOKS OF THIS MODULE?

Yes, this module includes a separate CSS file, especially for the look and feel of this module. Take a look in the settings section, under Stylesheets you can find a file called s3slider.css.

There you can edit all looks for the ribbon and the image.

I WOULD LIKE TO CHANGE THE FUNCTIONALITY OF THIS MODULE, WHERE AND HOW DO I START?

Well, there's 1 place you need to be,

1. to change the functionality you need to be in the **developer section** in the umbraco backend, under **XSLT Files** you will find 2 files called **jCarousel List Items** & **jCarousel List Item**.
jCarousel List Items is for the jCarousel folder, the actual slider. jCarousel List Item is for the image in the page of the details of the jCarousel item.

CAN I HIDE JCAROUSELITEMS FROM THE NAVIGATION OR SITEMAP?

Yes, the umbracoNaviHide property is added in the properties so you can choose to hide certain questions or categories from an automatically generated menu or site map.

PACKAGE CONTENT

STYLES

s3slider.css

this document contains all the data to style the slider module on your website. This can be customized to your own website style without problems.

XSLT

1. jcarousellistitems.xslt
This document contains the code to make the carousel.
The parameter 'title' can be used to enter a text for the title above the list.
2. jcarousellistitem.xslt
This document puts the image sized to the properties of the jCarousel folder on your page if you enabled this on the jCarousel folder, if not it will put the image there in the original size.

TEMPLATES

BoostMaster /jCarousel

This is the main template for this module, it is where the carousel is located and which links to the details of a jCarouselitem.

BoostMaster /jCarousel item

This template will display the details of a jCarousel item. The image here will be resized (or not) in the same way as in the carousel, depending on the settings of the jCarousel folder. If it is set to resize it will use the sizes defined in the jCarousel folder.

DOCUMENT TYPES

1. jCarousel
 - standard position for the ribbon
 - color of the ribbon
 - width of the ribbon when it's positioned on the left or right.
 - Width of the image
 - Height of the image
 - Do the images on the detail of a jCarouselitem need to be resized or not?
2. jCarouselitem
 - Custom position of the ribbon, only for this item
 - Title
 - Description
